

INSTALLATION STEPS

HITCH WEIGHT: 28 LBS.

INSTALL NOTES:

INSTALL TIME: 45 MINUTES

Drilling required, fishwiring hardware

1) Lift trunk lid and roll back carpeting to reveal trunk pan. Using a 1 1/2" hole saw, cut a hole in the location shown in the trunk pan figures above. Make sure hole is centered between the spot welds as shown.

- 2) After cutting one hole per side, fishwire a carriage bolt and block thru the drilled holes and down thru existing slots in the frame rails as shown above.
- 3) Lower exhaust to allow room for securing fasteners to carriage bolts.

- 4) Remove the bottom bolt from the bumper bracket and return to vehicle owner. One each side of vehicle.
- 5) Raise hitch into position, being careful not to push carriage bolts back into frame.
- 6) Insert the 5/16-18 screws into the holes in the bumper brackets and thru hitch side plates as shown. Position the hitch arms onto the carriage bolts and secure with fasteners as shown.
- 7) Torque all 1/2-13 hardware to 75 lb.-ft., Torque 5/16-18 hardware to 18 lb.-ft. Secure exhaust into position.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO INSURE THAT ALL FASTNERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
